New Classrooms at McLaren Vale Primary School

Amanda Rishworth MP, Federal Member for Kingston today attended the official opening of the new classrooms at McLaren Vale Primary School built as part of the Australian Government's Building the Education Revolution (BER).

McLaren Vale Primary School received \$3,200,000 under the National School Pride (NSP) program and Primary Schools for the 21st Century (P21) element of the BER.

Ms Rishworth congratulated McLaren Vale Primary School on their new facilities and spoke of the benefit to both the school and local community.

Ms Rishworth said "It has been wonderful to see the principal, school staff, parents and tradespeople working together to deliver this important project. Now that the new classrooms are complete, teachers and students at McLaren Vale Primary School will be teaching and learning in 21st Century facilities that they so richly deserve."

Ms Rishworth said the new facilities are not only a benefit to the school, but they are also supporting stronger social networks and community cohesion.

"It is tremendous to be here today to celebrate the opening of the new classrooms and to witness first hand, the impact this has had on McLaren Vale Primary School and the local community," said Ms Rishworth.

The BER is a key element of the Australian Government's \$42 billion Nation Building – Economic Stimulus Plan to support jobs, stimulate local economies and invest in important infrastructure for the long term.
