Today Federal Member for Kingston, Ms Amanda Rishworth announced a \$3 million funding program for the redevelopment of the Port Noarlunga Foreshore South of Adelaide.

“The funding will invest in community and sporting facilities to create local jobs and stimulate the local economy during the global economic recession” Ms Rishworth stated.

Ms Rishworth was joined by Minister for Sport Kate Ellis and representatives of the Onkaparinga Council, Councillor Mr Bill Jamieson and General Manager for Projects and Services, Mr Bruce William.

Minister for Sport and Recreation, Ms Ellis stated that “The Federal Government is proud to support community projects that develop local infrastructure, provide facilities for residents and support the local economy”

Federal funding for the Port Noarlunga development will contribute to the following projects Ms Rishworth stated

- Redevelopment of the foreshore north of the Jetty, incorporating a multi-use trail;
- Upgrade of the Witton Centre to deliver improved public infrastructure and provide better accommodation for children’s aquatic programs;
- Upgrade of facilities for the Port Noarlunga Surf Lifesaving Club to accommodate education, surf life saving and commercial activities;
- create a high quality and environmentally sustainable centre-piece on the foreshore; and
- integrate the car park and the foreshore to improve traffic flows.

Ms Rishworth is pleased that the people in the South will benefit from this Federal funding which builds onto the \$1.35 million previously allocated to the Onkaparinga Council this year for 58 smaller scale local community projects, under the Community Infrastructure Program.
