**Federal Government to Hold Community Cabinet
at Hallett Cove R-12 School**

Prime Minister Kevin Rudd will bring the Federal Ministry to Hallett Cove R-12 School, on Thursday August 14th for a Community Cabinet meeting.

“The South Australian community will have an opportunity to speak directly with Prime Minister Kevin Rudd and his Cabinet Ministers,” Ms. Rishworth said.

The meeting will be a historic moment for Adelaide’s South, marking the first Federal Community Cabinet to take place in South Australia’s history.

The suburb of Hallett Cove sits inside the electorate of Kingston, which is held by local member Amanda Rishworth.

Ms. Rishworth played an active role in campaigning for this historic event to be held in Adelaide’s South.

“This is such a fantastic opportunity for the local residents of Kingston,” Ms Rishworth said.

People who attend the meeting can expect an address from Prime Minister Kevin Rudd, followed by a question and answer session from members of the audience.

“The Rudd Government has pledged its commitment to listening to the views and experiences of local residents, so it can better serve their needs and interests in the community,” Ms. Rishworth said.

- 4.30 - 5.45pm** : Arrival/Registration
- 6:00 - 7.00pm**: Public forum commences.
 - Address by Prime Minister
 - Question and answer session from members of the audience
- 7:00 - 8.15pm**: Pre-arranged meeting with Cabinet Ministers

8:15 – 8:30pm: Close of session

South Australians who wish to attend the Community Cabinet meeting must register by Tuesday, August 5, but are advised to register early to guarantee a place at the meeting.

“We anticipate a large community presence at the meeting,” Ms. Rishworth said, “therefore it’s important for all interested parties to register their interest as early as possible.
