NBN Coming to Aldinga, Seaford and McLaren Vale Communities!

Amanda Rishworth MP, Federal Member for Kingston today welcomed NBN Co's announcement that the NBN fibre rollout will begin in the Aldinga area with construction works scheduled to commence in **March 2012** and in the Seaford and McLaren Vale areas with construction works scheduled to commence in **April 2012**.

Ms Rishworth said NBN Co, the company established to construct and operate the NBN, has now released its inaugural 12-month national rollout plan which includes the Aldinga, Seaford and McLaren Vale communities.

Ms Rishworth said "I am thrilled that construction is set to commence in the first half of next year so that businesses and residents in the Aldinga, Seaford and McLaren Vale areas have access to high-speed broadband.

"This exciting news builds on the successful rollout of the NBN in Willunga, and is further evidence that the NBN is well and truly a reality rolling out here in the South and right across Australia.

"Modern internet facilities will enable our local community to meet the demands of the 21st century and so I look forward to seeing construction on this vital infrastructure begin in these new local sites in early 2012."

Ms Rishworth said investment in the NBN is essential for Australia to be an innovative, prosperous, knowledge-based economy of the future.

The NBN will provide access to high-speed broadband to 100% of Australian premises. Under Labor, every home, school, hospital and business will receive high-speed broadband via the NBN – no one will miss out.
