### **EXPANDED SERVICES FOR LOCAL GP CLINIC IN SOUTH**

Frontline health services in the South will be expanded with the Wellbeing clinic in McLaren Vale receiving a \$108, 000 funding boost from the Gillard Government.

Federal Member for Kingston, Amanda Rishworth MP said the funding provided to Wellbeing through the Federal Government's Primary Care Infrastructure Grant will make it easier for patients in McLaren Vale to see their doctor close to home.

Ms Rishworth said "This grant will enable the clinic to make vital improvements including constructing a dedicated space to accommodate a practice nurse.

"We want patients to receive the right care at the right time. Making sure families can access the healthcare they need close to home is a key part of the Gillard Government's Health Reforms and these grants are making this happen here in Southern Adelaide."

Ms Rishworth said this grant builds on other local investments through the Primary Care Infrastructure Grants program including six local GP clinics that received funding to expand their services and upgrade their facilities in the previous round.
